**Incident:** Emergency Medical Services Incident – Narcan Used on Overdose Victim

On Wednesday, January 25, 2017 at 9:34 am, Police Officers Darrell Algarin and Jorge Medina responded to an “Emergency Medical Services” call at the Hardees, 350 Route 211 East. Upon arrival, the officers discovered a 34 year old, male, Middletown, N.Y. resident, semi-conscious in the restaurant’s restroom. The victim was unresponsive and demonstrating signs of an overdose. PO Algarin, assisted by PO Medina, began delivering emergency first aid, including the use of Department issued nasally delivered Narcan. Within a brief period, the victim regained consciousness and was subsequently transported by Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance Corps to Orange Regional Medical Center.
