Incident: Arrest – Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance
Location: 280 Bloomingburg Road, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.
Date/Time: August 18, 2017 / 6:39 pm

On Friday, August 18, 2017 at approximately 6:39 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officer Joseph DeAngelis, responded to a report for “Check the Welfare – Motorist Slumped Over the Wheel of an Automobile” at the Citgo Gas Station, 280 Bloomingburg Road. Upon arrival, the officer discovered Annemarie Webb, a 33 year old, Town of Wallkill resident, in her auto, ingesting narcotics. PO DeAngelis, aided by PO Ian Holmes, arrested Webb, who was found to be in possession of 56 packets of heroin, 37 oxycodone pills and a quantity of crack. The defendant was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree. The defendant was subsequently admitted to Orange Regional Medical Center because of illness related to the ingestion of the narcotics. During a bedside arraignment by Judge Perter Green, the defendant was remanded to Orange County Jail on \$15,000 cash/\$100,000 bond. Webb’s next court appearance is on Tuesday, August 22, 2017 at 10:00 am in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
