Incident: Emergency Medical Services Incident – Narcan Used on Overdose Victim
Location: Target, 1 North Galleria Drive, Town of Walkill, N.Y.
Date/Time: November 3, 2017 / 7:03 pm

On Friday, November 3, 2017 at 7:03 pm, Police Officer Michael Rinaldo responded to an “Emergency Medical Services” call at Target. Upon arrival, the officer discovered a 25 year old, male, Middletown, N.Y. resident, unconscious in the restroom. The victim was unresponsive and demonstrating signs of an overdose. PO Rinaldo began delivering emergency first aid, including administering two doses of Department issued nasally delivered Narcan. Shortly thereafter, Police Officer Laura Gannon administered a third dose of Narcan to the victim. Within a brief period, the victim regained consciousness and was subsequently transported by Mobil Life Support Services to Orange Regional Medical Center.
