**Incident:** Emergency Medical Services Call – Narcan Used on Overdose Victim  
**Location:** Berkman Drive, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.  
**Date/Time:** March 21, 2018 / 11:57 pm

On Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at 11:57 pm, Police Officers Stephanie Ruberto, Michael Condon and Jonathan Gomez responded to an “Emergency Medical Services” call behind a Berkman Drive residence. Upon arrival, the officers discovered a 30 year old, male, Town of Wallkill resident, unconscious on the ground. The victim was unresponsive and demonstrating signs of an overdose. Police Officers Ruberto and Condon assisted by Police Officer Gomez, began administering emergency first aid, including the use of Department issued nasally delivered Narcan. Within a minute, the victim regained consciousness and was transported to Orange Regional Medical Center by Mobile Life Support Services.
