**Incident: One Arrest – Burglary**  
**Location: Chromalloy, 105 Tower Drive, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.**  
**Date/Time: June 15, 2018 / 12:47 am**

On Friday, June 15, 2018, at approximately 12:47 am, Town of Wallkill Police Officers Jonathan Gomez and Brendan Smith responded to a “Burglary” at Chromalloy, 105 Tower Drive. Upon arrival, officers discovered Tomas Ruiz, a 39 year old, male, Town of Wallkill resident, had unlawfully entered the building. The defendant was charged with Burglary Third Degree and Petty Larceny. The defendant was arraigned by Judge Patrick Owen, and was remanded to Orange County Jail on \$5,000 cash / \$15,000 bond until his next court appearance on June 19, 2018 at 2:00 pm in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
