On Wednesday, August 22, 2018 at 5:43 pm, Town of Wallkill Detective Christopher DiNapoli arrested Tyquell Graham, a 20 year old, male, City of Middletown resident. Graham was arrested after an investigation disclosed that on August 5, 2018; the defendant displayed a handgun while forcibly removing property from a person who was visiting the Stevens Manor Apartments. Graham was charged with Robbery First Degree, Grand Larceny Fourth Degree and Menacing Second Degree.

The defendant was arraigned before Judge Peter Green, Town of Wallkill Court, where he was remanded to Orange County Jail on \$50,000 cash/\$100,000 bond. Graham's next scheduled court appearance is on August 24, 2018 at 10:00 am at the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
