On Monday, June 19, 2017, at approximately 9:50 pm, Town of Wallkill Detective Steven Miller apprehended the second suspect wanted in connection with the June 4<sup>th</sup> stabbing at JD's Sports Bar, 360 Route 211 East. One suspect was previously arrested. The second defendant is Kenneth Rosario, 23 years old, of Windsor Mews, Town of Wallkill, N.Y. Rosario was charged with Assault Second Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon Third Degree. The defendant was arraigned in the Town of Wallkill Court before Judge Patrick Owen and remanded to the Orange County Jail on \$75,000 bail / \$200,000 bond until his next court appearance on June 23, 2017 at 2:00 pm in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
