Incident: Arrest – Grand Larceny Auto
Location: Buckingham Mews, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: February 28, 2018 / 5:15 pm

On Wednesday, February 28, 2018 at 5:15 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officer Michael Rinaldo responded to a report of a “Vehicle Theft” on Buckingham Mews. Upon arrival, Officer Rinaldo was met by the complainant, a Domino’s Delivery Driver, who advised that two individuals had taken his auto while he was making a delivery. During the ensuing investigation, Police Officers Ian Holmes and Daniel Graham, stopped two suspects, one of whom fled on foot but was apprehended after a brief foot pursuit. Both suspects were arrested after they were identified by the victim. The stolen vehicle was subsequently recovered on Regency Court.

Suspect #1

Suspect #2

Middletown, NY
Charged with: Grand Larceny, Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle, Obstructing Governmental Administration and Criminal Possession of Marijuana

The defendants were arraigned before Judge Peter Green, Town of Wallkill Court, where they were released on their own recognizance. The defendants are scheduled to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court at 9:00 am on March 21, 2018.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
