Incident: Arrest – Residential Burglary
Location: 14 Airport Road, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: April 4, 2014/3:59 pm

On Friday, April 4, 2014, at approximately 3:59 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officer John Snellinger responded to 14 Airport Road, for a report of an assault. During the investigation a suspect was arrested after it was discovered that she burglarized a residence. The suspect is identified as Sandra Keller, a 51 year old female, who resides at 203 Genung Street in the Town of Wallkill. According to the victim, who resides at 14 Airport Road, she was in her home when there was a knock at the door. When a five (5) year old child who resides at the residence opened the door, the suspect pushed her way into the home, knocking the child to the ground. The victim stated that the suspect demanded to speak with her daughter who was not at the residence. According to the victim, the suspect then become violent and started breaking glassware before the victim was able to force the suspect out of the house. The suspect was apprehended in her automobile on Airport Road. After being transported to the Town of Wallkill Police Station, the suspect was administered a Breathalyzer examination which disclosed that she was intoxicated. Keller was charged with Burglary Second Degree, Criminal Mischief Fourth Degree, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, and Driving While Intoxicated. Keller was remanded to the Orange County Jail after his arraignment in the Town of Wallkill Court.
