Incident: Underage Drinking Initiative
Location: Various locations within the Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: November 3, 2015 between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm

On Tuesday, November 3, 2015, members of the Town of Wallkill Police Department, working in conjunction with Investigator Martin Rafferty of the New York State Liquor Authority, conducted an initiative which targeted establishments that sell alcohol to juveniles.

The following individuals were arrested after being observed selling alcohol to a juvenile:

Terry Hernandez - Baez, 19 years old, of Middletown, NY, at the El Bandito restaurant, 536 East Main Street.

Gilbert Hallidy, 53 years old, of Middletown, NY, at the Mr. Sushi restaurant, 400 Route 211 East.

Singh Manpreed, 22 years old, of Middletown, NY, at the Mobil on the Run gas station, 530 Route 211 East.

Valerie Santiago, 19 years old, of Middletown, NY, at the Cumberland Farms, 356 East Main Street.

Each of the suspects was charged with Unlawfully Dealing with a Child and issued an appearance ticket to appear at the Town of Wallkill Court on December 2, 2015 at 9:00 am.

Ongoing complaints from residents led to this effort, which was undertaken to curb the illegal sale of alcoholic beverages to minors within our community. Working alongside our partners in the community we will continue to identify and target locations that engage in the illegal sale of alcohol to minors.
