**Incident: Investigation: Missing Child Located**  
**Location: 360 Route 211 East, Town of Wallkill**  
**Date/Time: December 5, 2015 / 5:34 PM**

On Saturday, December 5, 2015 at approximately 5:34 pm, officers from this Department responded to a report of a “Missing Child” at Party Zone, 360 Route 211 East. Upon arrival, officers were met by Anthony Wright of Matamoras, PA, who reported that his six year old grandson was missing. According to Wright, he could not locate his grandson, a non-verbal special needs child, who was playing inside of Party Zone. Investigation into this incident led to a thorough search of the Party Zone, where the child was located, inside of an inflatable amusement ride, which had deflated due to a large scale power failure that impacted the Town of Wallkill as well as the surrounding area. This Department was assisted by the Orange County Sheriff’s Office, City of Middletown Police Department, New York State Police, Silver Lake Fire Department, Orange County Fire Coordinator and Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance Corp (“TOWVAC”).
