Incident: Attempted Robbery
Location: Citizens Bank, 253 Route 211 East, Town of Wallkill
Date/Time: December 14, 2015 /6:53 am

On December 14, 2015 at approximately 6:53 am, Police Officer Jeremy Warner responded to a report of an "Attempted Robbery" which occurred in the parking lot of Citizens Bank. The victim, a 51 year old Middletown, NY resident, reported that she exited her vehicle to deposit funds in the ATM. According to the victim, once she completed the transaction, she was approached by a male who forced the victim to enter her vehicle. As the victim was forced into her vehicle, the suspect demanded money from her. After the victim told the male that she had no money, the male fled on foot, empty handed, travelling east on Route 211. The victim was treated by her personal physician for a minor injury to her neck. The suspect is described as:

- 1) Male, black, 6'0", 200 pounds, wearing a long black coat, red ski mask and a dark cap.
