Incident: Bomb Threat – School Lockdown
Location: William A. Carter Elementary School, 435 East Main St., Town of Wallkill
Date/Time: January 12, 2016/9:25am

The Town of Wallkill Police Department reports that on Tuesday, January 16, 2016, at approximately 9:30am, members of the Town of Wallkill Police Department responded to a reported bomb threat at William A. Carter Elementary School. A school employee reported that at approximately 9:25am, a call was received at the William A. Carter Elementary School, by a male caller making a bomb threat. The school was placed into lockdown and members of the Town of Wallkill Police, New York State Police, Orange County Sheriff's Office, and City of Middletown Police conducted a search of the interior and exterior of buildings and grounds which failed to disclose any weapons or responsible person(s). There were no reported injuries, and at approximately 10:28am, the lockdown was lifted. The Investigation into the incident is being conducted by Town of Wallkill Detectives, assisted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
