Incident: Bomb Threat – School Lockdown
Location: Monhagen Middle School, County Route 78, Town of Wallkill
Date/Time: January 20, 2016/9:49 am

The Town of Wallkill Police Department reports that on Wednesday, January 20, 2016, at approximately 10:03 am, members of the Town of Wallkill Police Department responded to a reported bomb threat at Monhagen Middle School. A school employee reported that at approximately 9:49 am, a call was received at the Monhagen Middle School, by a male caller making a bomb threat. The school was placed into lockdown and members of the Town of Wallkill Police, New York State Police, Orange County Sheriff's Office, and City of Middletown Police conducted a search of the interior and exterior of buildings and grounds which failed to disclose any weapons or responsible person(s). There were no reported injuries, and at approximately 11:43am, the lockdown was lifted. The Middletown School District and the Federal Bureau of Investigations are assisting the Town of Wallkill Detectives with this investigation.
