**Incident:** Robbery – Suspect Arrested

On Friday, January 15, 2016 at approximately 7:59 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officers responded to a call for a “Robbery” at 1 North Galleria Drive. Upon arrival, officers were met by the male victim, a 16 year old City of Middletown resident. According to the victim, he was approached by a male acquaintance, who punched him in the face and removed the victim’s sneakers, sweatshirt and an undetermined amount of money.

The suspect who was subsequently identified as Douglas McFarlane, 16 years of age, residing on 5 Ebury Mews, Middletown, N.Y., was arrested at the Town of Wallkill Police Department, and charged with Robbery 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Grand Larceny 4<sup>th</sup> degree, and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5<sup>th</sup> degree by Town of Wallkill Detective Julia Ashworth. McFarlane was arraigned in the Town of Wallkill Court before the Honorable Peter Green, and was remanded to the Orange County Jail in lieu of \$3,000.00 cash bail or \$10,000.00 bond. He is scheduled to reappear in Court on January 26, 2016 at 9:00 am.
