Incident: Arrests – Detective Bureau Prostitution Investigation

On Tuesday, December 13, 2016, Town of Wallkill Detectives conducted a Prostitution Investigation in the Town of Wallkill that led to the arrest of four adults.

Defendant #1

George Brischler a 36 year old male, Sparrowbush resident. Brischler was charged with Patronizing a Prostitute. Brischler was released with an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear at the Town of Wallkill Court on January 4, 2017 at 9:00am.

Defendant #2

Monique Boyd a 33 year old female, City of Middletown resident. Monique Boyd was charged with Prostitution. The defendant was arraigned before Judge Peter Green, Town of Wallkill Court, where she was remanded to Orange County Jail \$1,500 bail/\$3,000 bond. The defendant's next appearance is on January 4, 2017 at 9:00 am.

Defendant #3

Allen L. Maja a 28 year old female, Town of Wallkill resident. Maja was charged with Prostitution. Maja was released with an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear at the Town of Wallkill Court on January 4, 2017 at 9:00am.

Defendant #4

Dominique Morris a 29 year old female, Town of Newburgh resident. Morris was charged with Prostitution. The defendant was arraigned before Judge Peter Green, Town of Wallkill Court, where she was remanded to Orange County Jail \$2,000 bail/\$4,000 bond. The defendant's next appearance is on January 4, 2017 at 9:00 am.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed
