**Incident:** Arrest – Operating a Motor Vehicle While Under the Influence of Drugs –  
Narcan Used to Revive Operator  
**Location:** 474 Route 211 East, Town of Wallkill, NY

On Tuesday, September 26, 2017 at approximately 12:04 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officer Michael Nolte responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident in the Home Depot parking lot, 474 Route 211 East. Upon arrival, officers, including Deputy Chief Antonino Spano, and Sergeant Patrick Marcial, discovered that a vehicle had collided with an unoccupied parked automobile. The operator, Matthew Green, 30 years old, of Monroe, NY, was unresponsive and demonstrating signs of an overdose. PO Nolte began delivering emergency first aid, including the use of Department issued nasally delivered Narcan. Within a brief period, Green regained consciousness and was subsequently transported by Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance Corps to Orange Regional Medical Center. Officers recovered drug paraphernalia, including a hypodermic syringe and empty glassines from the auto. Green was arrested and charged with Operating a Motor Vehicle While Under the Influence of Drugs and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle. He was subsequently released and is scheduled to appear before Judge Patrick Owen in the Town of Wallkill Court at 2:00 pm on October 31, 2017.
