**Incident:** Arrest - Possession of Forged Credit Cards  
**Location:** Walmart 470 Route 211 East, Town of Wallkill, NY  
**Date/Time:** March 16, 2014/ 12:59 pm

On Sunday, March 16, 2014, at approximately 12:59 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officer Darek Tyminski responded to Walmart after a security officer contacted police to report that two individuals were acting suspiciously. After an investigation determined that the two individuals were in possession of thirty-five forged credit cards, the suspects were arrested and charged with Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument Second Degree. The first suspect is identified as Tyshon Morancie, a 27 year old male of 80 East 93<sup>rd</sup> Street, Brooklyn, NY 11212. The second suspect is identified as James Young, a 24 year old male, also of 80 East 93<sup>rd</sup> Street, Brooklyn, NY 11212. Both of the defendants were remanded to the Orange County Jail after their arraignment in the Town of Wallkill Court. Detectives working in conjunction with the New York State Police and the United States Secret Service are continuing their investigation into this case.
