Incident: Emergency Medical Services Incident – Narcan Used on Overdose Victim
Location: Super 8 Motel, 563 Route 211 EAST, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.
Date/Time: October 22, 2016 / 5:39 pm

On Saturday, October 22, 2016 at 5:39 pm, Police Officers Brian Levy and Christine Kohlberger responded to a “Request for Emergency Medical Services – Male Not Breathing,” in Room 112 at the Super 8 Motel, 563 Route 211 East. Upon arrival at the scene, the officers discovered the 31 year old, Monroe, N.Y. resident, unconscious in the motel room bathroom. As PO Levy was preparing to administer his Department issued nasally delivered Narcan to the victim, paramedic Jackie Griswold and Cecil Hunter of the Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance Corp (“TOWVAC”) arrived on the scene. Working together, the officers and TOWVAC personnel administered two doses of NARCAN to the victim. Within a brief period, the victim regained consciousness and was subsequently transported by TOWVAC to Orange Regional Medical Center, where the victim was treated and subsequently released.
