Incident: Emergency Medical Services Incident – Narcan Used on Overdose Victim
Location: Cumberland Farms, 356 East Main Street, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.

On Wednesday, April 18, 2018 at 11:19 am, Police Officers Julia Ashworth, Robert Clark, Anthony Napolitano and Orange County Sheriff's Deputy Timothy McLaughlin responded to an "Emergency Medical Services" call at the Cumberland Farms, 356 East Main Street. Upon arrival, the officers discovered a 26 year old, male, Town of Wallkill resident, unconscious on the bathroom floor. The victim was unresponsive and demonstrating signs of an overdose. Deputy McLaughlin, began administering emergency first aid, including the use of Department issued nasally delivered Narcan. Subsequently, PO Ashworth assisted by PO Clark administered four additional doses of Narcan. Within a few minutes, the victim regained consciousness and was transported by Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance Corps to Orange Regional Medical Center.
