Incident: Emergency Medical Services Incident – Narcan Used on Overdose Victim
Location: Walmart, 470 Route 211 East, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.
Date/Time: June 10, 2018 /11:36 pm

On Sunday, June 10, 2018 at 11:36 pm, Sergeant Jonathan Kitsos and Daniel Graham responded to an “Emergency Medical Services” call at the Walmart, 470 Route 211 East. Upon arrival, the officers discovered a 30 year old, male, Chester resident, unconscious on the sidewalk. The victim was unresponsive and demonstrating signs of an overdose. Police Officer Graham then began administering emergency first aid, including the use of Department issued nasally delivered Narcan. Subsequently, PO Graham administered an additional dose of Narcan. Within a few minutes, the victim regained consciousness and was transported by Goshen Volunteer ambulance to Orange Regional Medical Center.
