Incident: One Arrest – Assault
Location: Walmart, 470 Route 211 East, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.

On Wednesday, June 13, 2018, at approximately 10:34 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officers Gregory Hart, Daniel Graham and Jonathan Gomez responded to an “Assault” at Walmart, 470 Route 211 East. Upon arrival, officers discovered the victim, a 27 year old, male, Bloomingburg resident, suffering from stab wounds to his throat. The victim was transported to Orange Regional Medical Center by Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance Corps. A subsequent investigation by Detective Jeremy Warner resulted in the arrest of Cheyanne Hasbrouck, 24 years old, Bloomingburg. The defendant was charged with Assault First Degree. The defendant was arraigned by Judge Patrick Owen, and was remanded to Orange County Jail on \$100,000 cash / \$300,000 bond until her next court appearance on June 19, 2018 at 12:00 pm in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
