Incident: Arrest – Forgery

Location: Bert Crawford Road. Town of Wallkill, N.Y.

Date/Time: June 22, 2018 / 5:30 pm

On Friday, June 22, 2018, at approximately 5:30 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Detective Christopher DiNapoli arrested Amy Wase, 38 years old, at her residence. Wase was arrested after an investigation disclosed that she had fraudulently cashed checks at several banks. The defendant was charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property, Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument, Grand Larceny Fourth Degree and Identity Theft First Degree. The defendant was arraigned by Judge Peter Green, and was released on her own recognizance until her next court appearance on June 27, 2018 at 9:00 am in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
