Incident: Arrest – Robbery
Location: Patio Road Park, Town of Wallkill

On Friday, July, 13, 2018, at 6:30 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Detective Christopher DiNapoli and Police Officer Robert Reid arrested Jah-Quan Williams, 20 year old, Town of Wallkill resident. Williams was arrested after an investigation disclosed that on May 31, 2018, Williams, along with several others, punched a Town of Wallkill resident and removed his iPhone. Williams was charged with Robbery in the Third Degree, and Petit Larceny.

The defendant was arraigned before Judge Patrick Owen, Town of Wallkill Court, where he was remanded to Orange County Jail in lieu of \$3,000 cash/ \$10,000 bond. The defendant is scheduled to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court at 2:00 am on July 17, 2018.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
