On November 29, 2018 at 1:20 pm, Town of Wallkill Detective Christopher DiNapoli arrested Owusu A. Agyeman, a 19 year old, male, City of Middletown resident. Agyeman was arrested after an investigation disclosed that on October 17, 2018, the defendant, who is an employee of Staples located at 470 Route 211E, Town of Wallkill, took a photograph of the victim's credit card and made online purchases from Amazon, Venmo and NFL Shop. Agyeman was charged with Unlawful Possession of Personal Information Third Degree, and Petit Larceny.

The defendant was released with an appearance ticket to appear before Judge Peter Green, Town of Wallkill Court on December 19, 2018 at 9:00 am at the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
