Incident: Arrest – Stabbing
Location: Boulder Point Apartments – 203 Genung Street, Apartment 803, Town of Wallkill
Date/Time: January 9, 2020/10:50 am

On Thursday, January 9, 2020 at 10:50 am, Town of Wallkill Police responded to reported domestic incident at Boulder Point Apartments located at 203 Genung Street, Apt 803, Town of Wallkill, for a domestic in which a stabbing occurred. The victim of the assault, a 27 year old Town of Wallkill resident, reported that she was stabbed by her wife. The victim was transported and treated at Orange Regional Medical Center (ORMC), listed in stable condition for stab wounds to her arm and back. A subsequent investigation led to the arrest of Jasmine J. Criss, a 24 year old, Town of Wallkill resident. Jasmin Criss was charged with Assault 2nd Degree (felony) and Criminal Possession of a weapon 4th degree (misdemeanor). City of Middletown Police assisted with the investigation.

The defendant was arraigned in the Town of Mount Hope Court before Judge John Goldsmith and remanded to the Orange County Jail on \$2,500 bail / \$5,000 bond until her next court appearance on January 14, 2020 at 2:00 pm in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
