On June 11, 2014 beginning at approximately 6:00 am, Town of Wallkill Detectives and Uniformed Police Officers, under the direct supervision of Sergeant Robert McLymore conducted an operation targeting defendants who were wanted on outstanding warrants. The warrant sweep resulted in the arrest James H. Cherry, 41 years old, of Monhagen Avenue, Middletown, NY. Detective Christopher Hults arrested Cherry, who was wanted on an outstanding warrant for failing to appear in the Town of Wallkill Court in connection with his February 2013 arrest for Forcible Touching of a female victim. Cherry was arraigned in the Town of Wallkill Court before the Honorable Patrick Owen, and was remanded to the Orange County Jail, until his next scheduled appearance on June 12, 2014 at 2:00 pm. As part of our ongoing efforts to reduce crime, the Town of Wallkill Police Department will continue to perform warrant sweeps to apprehend known wanted defendants.
