Incident: Arrests – Educational Law- Unauthorized Acts
Location: Various Locations, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: Thursday, June 30, 2022, 11:30 am

On Thursday, June 30, 2022 at approximately 11:30am, the Town of Wallkill Detectives in conjunction with the Orange County Drug Task Force, conducted an investigation into reported illicit activities at massage parlors in the Town of Wallkill. The investigation led to the arrest of the following three adults.

Defendant #1

Sook Cuimnd, a 61 year old female, Town of Wallkill resident. Cuimnd was charged with Unauthorized Acts. Cuimnd was released with an appearance ticket and scheduled to appear at the Town of Wallkill Court on July 20, 2022 at 9:00am. The defendant was arrested at the Botanical Day Spa, 253 Tower Drive, Middletown NY.

Defendant #2

Xiao F. Pan, a 45 year old female, Town of Wallkill resident. Pan was charged with Unauthorized Acts. Pan was released with an appearance ticket and scheduled to appear at the Town of Wallkill Court on July 20, 2022 at 9:00am. The defendant was arrested at the Botanical Day Spa, 253 Tower Drive, Middletown NY.

Defendant #3

Chunlan A. Li, a 52 year old female, Flushing NY resident. Li was charged with Unauthorized Acts. Li was released with an appearance ticket and scheduled to appear at the Town of Wallkill Court on July 20, 2022 at 9:00am. The defendant was arrested at King Relaxation, 349 NY-211, Middletown NY.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
