Incident: **Robbery – Suspect Arrested**
Location: **481 Route 211 East, Town of Wallkill**
Date/Time: **September 11, 2014/3:51 am**

On Thursday, September 11, 2014 at approximately 3:51 am, Town of Wallkill Police Officers responded to a call for a “Robbery” at 481 Route 211 East. Upon arrival, officers were met by the female victim, a 20 year old City of Middletown resident. According to the victim, she was approached by a male acquaintance, who asked her for a ride to City of Middletown. Once inside of the victim’s automobile, the male, later identified as Daniel Rasheem Ligon, 27 years old, of West Conkling Avenue, Middletown, N.Y., threatened to assault the victim unless she surrendered her money to him. After removing an undetermined amount of money from the victim, Ligon fled west on Route 211. A short time later, Ligon was apprehended at 7 Fortune Road West. Ligon was arrested by Detective Julia Ashworth and charged with Robbery. He was arraigned at the Town of Wallkill Court before the Honorable Judge Joseph Owen. Ligon was remanded to Orange County Jail.
