Incident: Attempted Carjacking
Location: Parking Lot Maple Hill Park, California Avenue, Town of Wallkill
Date/Time: January 1, 2015 /3:15 pm

On January 1, 2015 at approximately 3:15 pm, Police Officer Christopher DiNapoli responded to a Motor Vehicle Collision in the parking lot of Maple Hill Park. The victim, a 26 year old Middletown, NY resident, reported that she was in her parked vehicle, when she was approached by a male that was armed with a handgun. According to the victim, the male ordered the victim to exit her vehicle. The victim reported that as she attempted to exit the vehicles passenger door, the vehicle moved forward, until it struck a tree. The collision caused the victim to be ejected from the vehicle. The victim was transported by Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance (TOWVAC) to Orange Regional Medical Center (ORMC), where she underwent treatment for fractured pelvis and a dislocated hip. The suspect is described as:

- 1) Male, black, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt.
