Incident: Arrest – Robbery
Location: Silverlake Deli, 599 Silverlake Scotchtown Road, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.

On Monday, January 16, 2017 at 8:50 pm, Town of Wallkill Detectives arrested Emiliano Navarro, a 17 year old, male, Town of Wallkill resident. Navarro was arrested after an investigation disclosed that at 8:25 pm on January 12, 2017, the defendant threatened staff at Silverlake Deli with a steak knife in an attempt to obtain merchandise. Navarro was charged with Attempted Robbery in the First Degree and Menacing in the Second Degree.

The defendant was arraigned before the Honorable Judge Patrick Owen, Town of Wallkill Court, where he was remanded to Orange County Jail on \$25,000 cash/\$75,000 bond. Navarro's next scheduled court appearance is on January 20, 2017 at 2:00 pm at the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
