Incident: Motor Vehicle Collision Involving an Automobile and a Bicycle – Two Children Injured
Location: Carpenter and Wisner Avenues, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: April 6, 2014 / 4:15 pm

On Sunday, April 6, 2014 at 4:15 pm, members of this Department responded to a report of a motor vehicle collision at the intersection of Carpenter and Wisner Avenues. Upon arrival officers discovered that a pickup truck being operated by William Jankowski, of Park Circle Drive, Town of Wallkill, collided with a bicycle with two passengers; Concetta Giaculli, 13 years old and Tamara Giaculli, 9 years old. The collision occurred while Mr. Jankowski's vehicle was travelling westbound on Carpenter Avenue and the bicycle was travelling southbound on Wisner Avenue. Concetta Giaculli, of Corwin Avenue, Town of Wallkill, was the most serious injured and was flown to Westchester County Medical Center where she is in stable condition with a head injury and a fractured pelvis. Tamara Giaculli, also of Corwin Avenue, was treated and released last evening from Orange Regional Medical Center for minor injuries. Neither William Jankowski, nor his passenger was injured in the collision. Investigation into the accident is ongoing at this time; however no summonses have been issued.
