Incident: Arrest – Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance

Location: Greenway Terrace and Hampton Court, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.

Date/Time: August 30, 2017 / 5:09 pm

On Wednesday, August 30, 2017 at approximately 5:09 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officer Joseph DeAngelis, working in conjunction with members of the Orange County Drug Task Force, and Police Officer Christopher Tulp, arrested Sheldon Victor, a 26 year old, Town of Wallkill resident. Victor was arrested at Greenway Terrace and Hampton Court after he was found to be in possession of oxycodone and marijuana. The defendant was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree and Unlawful Possession of Marijuana. The defendant was arraigned by Judge Peter Green, and was remanded to Orange County Jail on \$3,000 cash/\$6,000 bond. Victor's next court appearance is on Wednesday, September 6, 2017 at 9:00 am in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
