Incident: Motor Vehicle Collision Involving Two Vehicles – One Person Seriously Injured
Location: Carpenter and Wisner Avenues, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: April 11, 2014 / 1:23 pm

On Friday, April 11, 2014 at 1:23 pm, members of this Department responded to a report of a motor vehicle collision at the intersection of Carpenter and Wisner Avenues. Upon arrival Police Officer Darrell Algarin discovered that a vehicle being operated by Amida Redzepovski, 38 years old, of Blumel Road, Town of Wallkill collided with a vehicle being operated by Kenya Shaha Keels, 23 years old, of Sheffield Drive, Town of Wallkill. After the initial collision, Ms. Redzepovski's vehicle went on to strike a utility pole, leaving Ms. Redzepovski, who is five (5) months pregnant, trapped in the vehicle. After being extricated by members of the Mechanicstown Fire Department, Ms. Redzepovski was flown to Westchester County Medical Center, where she is being treated for serious head injuries. The collision occurred as Ms. Redzepovski's vehicle was travelling northbound on Carpenter Avenue when it collided with Ms. Keels' vehicle which was travelling southbound on Carpenter Avenue and turning eastbound onto Wisner Avenue. Investigation into the accident is still ongoing at this time.
