**Incident:      Emergency Medical Services Call – Narcan Used on Overdose Victim**

On Monday, February 25, 2019 at 8:59 pm, Police Officers Michael Condon, John Zonneveld, Christopher Orengo, and Detective Christopher Dinapoli responded to an “Emergency Medical Services” call for service at 501 Route 211 East, Room 73. Upon arrival, the officer discovered a 35 year old, female, Middletown resident, unconscious on the floor. The victim was unresponsive and demonstrating signs of an overdose. Police Officers Condon and Zonneveld administered emergency first aid, including the use of Department issued nasally delivered Narcan. The victim regained consciousness and was transported to Orange Regional Medical Center by Town Of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance Corps.
