Incident: One Arrest – Menacing
Location: State Hwy 17, Town of Wallkill, N.Y.

On Wednesday, July 31, 2019, at approximately 3:05 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officers Devon Sanborn and John Zonneveld responded to a road rage “Menacing” complaint involving a firearm which occurred on NY State Highway 17. The officers located the suspect, Tiffany McGinn, a 30 year old, female, Town of Wallkill resident at Orange Regional Urgent Care, 707 East Main St., Middletown. A subsequent search of the suspects auto, led to the discovery of a licensed loaded 9mm pistol. The defendant was charged with Menacing 2nd degree and released with an appearance ticket to return to the Town Of Wallkill Court on August 8, 2019 at 9:00 am to appear before the Honorable Judge Peter Green.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
