**Incident: Assault with a Weapon – One Arrest**  
**Location: Walmart 470 Rt. 211 E., Town of Wallkill**  
**Date/Time: November 18, 2019 / 4:18 pm**

On Monday, November 18, 2019 at approximately 4:18 pm, members of the Town of Wallkill Police Department responded to a “Report of Assault with a Weapon” at 470 Rt. 211 E. Subsequently, Sergeant Patrick Marcial, Police Officers Luke Solomon and Daniel Traumburg, apprehended the defendant, Chiyoka Williams, a 37 year-old female, Town of Wallkill resident for stabbing the victim, a 24 year old female. The victim was transported to Orange Regional Medical Center by Town of Wallkill Volunteer Ambulance where she is admitted in stable condition. The defendant was charged with Assault Second Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon Fourth Degree. The defendant was arraigned in the Town of Wallkill Court before Judge Patrick Owen and was remanded to the Orange County Jail on \$50,000 bail / \$150,000 bond until her next court appearance on November 19, 2019 at 2:00 pm in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
