**Incident:** Arrest – Robbery  
**Location:** 441 Rt. 211 E, Town of Wallkill  
**Date/Time:** October 26, 2019 / 4:30 am

On Saturday, October 26, 2019 at 4:30 am, Town of Wallkill Police Officers responded to a report of a “Robbery” at Wendy’s Restaurant, 441 Rt. 211E. The investigation disclosed that the defendant, Daniel Webster, a 44 year old, male, Middletown, NY resident, entered Wendy’s Restaurant through the rear door displaying what appeared to be a silver handgun and demanded the manager to open the safe. The defendant removed an unknown amount of U.S. currency from the safe and exited the rear door.

A subsequent investigation by Detective Robert Reid led to the arrest of the defendant on November 13, 2019. The defendant was charged with Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5<sup>th</sup> Degree.

The defendant was arraigned in the Town of Wallkill Court before Judge Patrick Owen and remanded to the Orange County Jail on \$80,000 bail / \$240,000 bond until his next court appearance on November 19, 2019 at 2:00 pm in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
