Incident: Arrest – Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance
Location: Silverlake Scotchtown Road, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: May 15, 2020 / 5:07 pm

On Friday, May 15, 2020 at 5:07 pm, Town of Wallkill Police Officers Michael Condon and Christopher Orengo responded to a two car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Silverlake Scotchtown and Mud Mills Roads. After a brief investigation, Police Officer Christopher Orengo search of the involved vehicle led to the recovery of 181 glassine envelopes of heroin and hypodermic needles. The defendant, Niki Capaci, 37 year old, female, City of Middletown resident, was arrested and charged with Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance Fifth Degree, Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance Seventh Degree and Criminal Possession of a Hypodermic Instrument.

The defendant was released with an appearance ticket to appear before Judge Joseph Owens, at the Town of Wallkill Court on June 4, 2020 at 12:00pm.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
