Incident: One Arrest – Assault
Location: 4 Avoncroft Lane, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: July 16, 2022/2:00 am

On Saturday, July 16, 2022, at approximately 2:00 am, Town of Wallkill Police Officers responded to an “Assault” at 4 Avoncroft Lane. Upon arrival, Officer Joseph Levy discovered the victim, a 43 year old, female, Town of Wallkill resident suffering from a stab wound to the chest. The victim was transported to Garnet Health Medical Center by Town Of Wallkill Emergency Medical Services for medical treatment. A subsequent investigation by Officer Justin Farrenkopf resulted in the arrest of Johnathan Harris, 40 years old, Town of Wallkill resident. The defendant was charged with Burglary First Degree, Assault Second Degree, Criminal Contempt First Degree, Criminal Mischief Fourth Degree, Criminal Possession Of A Weapon Fourth Degree, Driving While Intoxicated. The defendant was arraigned by Judge Michael Worden, and was remanded to Orange County Jail on \$50,000 cash / \$100,000 bond until his next court appearance on July 20, 2022 at 9:00 am in the Town of Wallkill Court.

A criminal charge is merely an allegation by the police that a defendant has committed a violation of the criminal law, and it is not evidence of guilt. All defendants are presumed innocent and entitled to a fair trial, during which it will be the State of New York’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
